Guidelines for the Reception of Communion

"As Catholics, we fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when we receive Holy Communion. Since the Eucharist is "The source and summit of the Christian life." (*Lumen Gentium*, #11) We are encouraged to receive Communion devoutly and frequently. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, participants should not be conscious of grave sin and normally should have fasted for one hour.

When should Catholics not receive the Eucharist?

A person who is conscious of grave sin is not to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord without prior sacramental confession except for a grave reason where there is no opportunity for confession. In this case, the person is to be mindful of the obligation to make an act of perfect contrition, including the intention of confessing as soon as possible (canon 916). A frequent reception of the Sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all." [i]

• If you have a mortal sin on your soul. For example, some serious sins include (but are not limited to) being married outside the Church, being unmarried but living together, using pornography, or purposely not attending Sunday Mass or holy days of obligation. For more info on what constitutes a mortal sin, refer to the Catechism of the Catholic Church 1857 -1859.

• If you have not observed the Eucharistic fast of one hour before receiving.

• If you have not yet received First Communion.

• If you do not believe the Eucharist to be Christ Himself (Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity).
