Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today, we as the Church throughout the world to celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. Even though the term Trinity is not plainly mentioned in the Bible, we can see the God reveals to us as three entities: Father, Son (Jesus Christ), and Holy Spirit in various ways in the Old Testament (OT) and New Testament (NT). Even there is the distinction among the three, but they are One in co-eternal existent and share the same Divine Essence – Holy, Loving, Merciful, Just, Transcendence, ... and the Creator of all things visible and invisible in God's goodness. The Holy Trinity is also called as the Holy Triune God. We can see that revelation of the Holy Trinity to the fullness through Jesus' birth, baptism and his Pascal Mystery, which is the Death and Resurrection of the Lord.

Let us first look at a few Scriptural passages from the Old Testament that reveal the Holy Trinity or the Holy Triune God. In Genesis 1:3 and 1:9, through God's Word and things came to into existence. Then in Genesis 2:7, God breathed the Breath of Life into the nostrils to give life to the first human. In Genesis 15:1, through the Spirit, the Word of the Lord (the Father) came to Abraham in the vision to comfort him and to assure him with God's great reward for his faith. Parallel was revealed about the Holy Trinity in the OT, in the NT, John 1:14 tells that "And the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us, and we saw his glory, the glory as of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth." Then John 20:22 tells that "And when he (the Risen Lord) said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.""

In the NT, we can recognize the Holy Trinity in the dialogue between the angel Gabriel and Mary in Luke 1:26-38 – the angel Gabriel tells Mary that she has "found favor with God. Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus... The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the Power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore, the child to be born will be call holy, the Son of God."

Then in the narrative of the Baptism of the Lord in Matthew 3:16-17, we learn that "the Spirit of God descends like a dove, and a voice from heaven proclaims, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well please." This tells us the Holy Trinity is intimately and actively working together as one like in the Genesis, but to begin the 'work of rede through God's sacrificial and unconditional love.

Before the ascension back to the Father, the Risen Lord gave the "Great Commission" to the Apostles to carrying on the work of salvation to all nations, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."

As we are celebrating the Solemnity of the Holy Triune God, let us pray that our church family together with all Faithful around the world will continue to learn, working together in God's redemptive and merciful love, and to be united in one heart, mind, and soul as one Body of Christ, the Church like the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit is One. And may our lives and services allow the others to see the presence and glory of the Holy Triune God in the world, and they also join us in worships and services, and carry on the loving and merciful works of redemption in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
