Pastoral's Pondering. Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord!

Happy Birthday, Catholic Church! Pentecost is one of the most ancient feasts in the church. 50 days after Easter, Jesus gives to the church the Holy Spirit. Pentecost (literally: "fifty-days") was originally a Jewish feast commemorating the giving of the Ten Commandments at Mount Sinai, which took place 50 days after the first Passover Meal. Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, the beginning of the Church with the coming of the Holy Spirit. May we be open to the gifts of the Holy Spirit to strengthen and guide us.

For the Eucharistic Congress, Bishop Mark writes, "As you are well aware, we are looking forward to our final Eucharistic Congresses in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston on June 2-3 at the Basilica of the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart.
